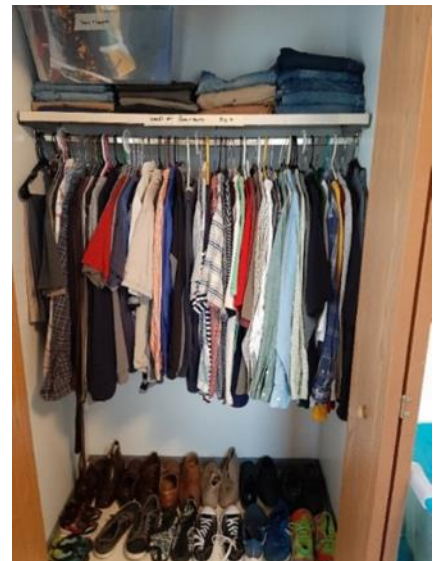

If your child(ren) need supplies, United Way is happy to help. Attend one of these distribution dates to receive a backpack and school supplies.

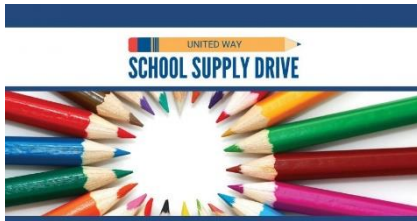

Area Farmer Markets that Accept SNAP

Moorhead Farmers Market

Hjemkomst Center Parking Lot – 202 1st Avenue North, Moorhead

Tuesdays 3:00 pm -6:00 pm

- **Accepts Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits as payment with an added perk of Double Bucks that allows shoppers to double their benefits up to \$10 for SNAP-eligible foods. New this year, an additional dollar for dollar match up to \$10, called Produce Bucks, will be given to spend on produce items. That means a \$10 swipe on the EBT Card will get participants \$30 to spend on fresh local foods.**
- **Power of Produce (POP) Club: Each week, children ages 4-12 receive a \$2 token to spend on produce!**

- **Accepts Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits as payment and will match up to \$15 in SNAP per person per market day. When you spend \$15 from your account, you get \$30 in market tokens.**
- **MATBUS provides free rides to the market and vouchers are available for download on their website.**
